

# Armenia

November 2020

As of 10 November, the statement signed by the leaders of Armenia, Azerbaijan and Russia entered into force, putting end to the ongoing armed conflict that started on 27 September in **Nagorno-Karabakh (NK)**.

While **no official request for assistance** was received from the Government, UNHCR/UN team in Armenia were authorized to provide complementary humanitarian assistance to 10 municipalities across the country.

As UNHCR has been mentioned in the statement from 9 November **to supervise the return of refugees and internally displaced persons**, UNHCR is in close contact with relevant authorities.

UNHCR complementary humanitarian assistance\* to Vayots Dzor, Tavush, Ararat, Lori, Syunik, Gegharkunik, Armavir; Kotayk and Yerevan is comprised of:

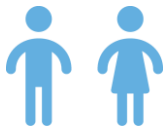
hygienic supplies	<b>24,000 persons</b>
bedding items	<b>8,000 persons</b>
folding beds	<b>2,300 persons</b>
electric heaters	<b>2,200 households</b>

**24,000 non-food kits** are distributed in 10 locations identified by the Government



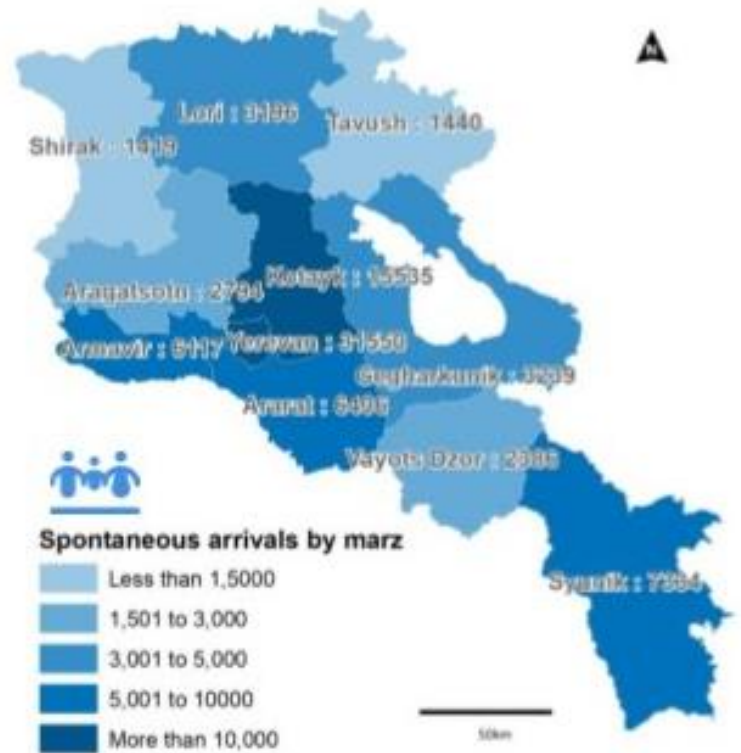
**1,500 children** benefit from child protection project in five regions of Armenia
